

Attention Parents, a case of Head Lice has been discovered in the Napoleon School. It is possible that other children in the school have been exposed to this communicable parasite. You are advised to carefully observe your child to prevent ongoing spread of the parasite.

Lice do not hop, jump or fly. They crawl. Itching happens when lice bite and suck blood from the scalp. This is a sign that lice are present. Not everyone will feel itching. Lice and eggs/nits can be seen if one looks very closely. Lice move very quickly.

The Napoleon School has a "No Nit" policy which means no nits can be seen before the child returns to school.
